We hope you're enjoying summer as much as we are at Heaven's Gait Ranch! Since our summer session is underway, we have exciting news to share with you, as our programs are steadily growing with your continued prayers and support.

Equine-Assisted Activities & Therapies: EAAT Education

Our EAAT Education program primarily includes unmounted activities that teach the basics of horsemanship, working from the ground up. For instance, individuals can learn how to groom, lead, and tack their horses -- activities that help participants develop gross and fine motor skills while focusing on an animal instead of themselves.

Certified Therapeutic Riding Instructor Micah Keshenberg facilitates all the lessons based on the individual's needs and goals; therefore, we have the opportunity to get pretty creative when the horse becomes a large motivator for learning. Participant Andrew Duszynski offers a perfect program highlight.

Meet Andrew

Andrew Duszynski was born with metopic synostosis, a skull deformity that interferes with the brain's development within the first year of life. After having surgery, Andrew's skull slowly made room for his brain to grow. However, his speech and language suffered. For years, he tried speech therapy in a clinic, but after much fuss and little progress, his mother Jaci sought other options.



That's when Andrew started coming to Heaven's Gait Ranch -- along with his speech therapist from the clinic. He now practices consonant blends to enhance fluency while riding his horse Ellie. The eight year old willingly ends every riding lesson by reading his horse a story out loud.

Here Andrew is reading Ellie a chapter of *Koko's Story* -- a fitting selection considering it's about the gorilla who learned to communicate using sign language. Andrew only paused twice during this reading session: the first time to show Ellie a picture of Koko and the second time to tell her that he too learned sign language just to be understood.

Therapeutic Riding

Since our spring session, we've added a variety of participants to our therapeutic riding program, including individuals with ataxia-telangiectasia, apraxia of speech, and autism spectrum disorders, just to name a few. On Tuesdays a group of adults with developmental disabilities take a shuttle together from Balance, Inc., a community organization out of Grafton, WI, and the participants just love interacting with the horses.

Equine Services for Heroes

Free to U.S. Military Veterans, this program has also become highly individualized for the participants enrolled, although they share some common experiences and abilities. It is no surprise that the veterans have established meaningful bonds with their horses, which makes the ranch a place they look forward to visiting each week.
